and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve 1 to 10 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Atty C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Brancalle  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Brancalle

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: No.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one only.  
I served prole since first of Dec. 1924  
at Garfield Utah
