Application of J. M. Chapman

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination to leave State and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The state prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of receiving stolen property

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the twenty eighth day of September, A. D. 1923, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in second district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of one year To five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Att. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James M. Chapman  
I was convicted under the name of James M. Chapman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: John Legedi

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
