and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8 day of November
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Richie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 year to 20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Meyers
I was convicted under the name of Edward Meyers
