Application of Edward Meyers

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Thirteenth day of October  
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable S. G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Meyers  
I was convicted under the name of Edward Meyers

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
