I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~order~~ or parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Box Elder County Jail having in my possession an auto under conviction and a sentence on a charge of upon which the manufacturers identification had been changed- a misdemeanor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of September A. D. 1925, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in City Court of Brigham City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred J. Holton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve 3 months in the County Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Box Elder County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable J. W. Horsely, county attorney prosecuted the case.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None, a misdemeanor connected with the sale of liquor
