County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve from three months to two years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Chas. J. Wahlquist prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Aime.  
I was convicted under the name of John Aime
