Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November  
A. D. 1924, at Ogden Utah County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimbal presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Serve from One  
to Ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable Judge Kimbal prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lowell Leo Nyle  
I was convicted under the name of Harry Robinson
