Application of Arthur O. Young.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3 day of Sept. A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Judge Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arthur O. Young I was convicted under the name of " " "

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Emil Eckman and B. S. Cambron. (They Have been Terminated.)

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE.
