I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole from State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of November, A. D. 1927, at Provo, Utah County of Utah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Worthing presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable M. E. Pope prosecuted the case.
