First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving owner of automobile

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of July,
A. D. 1932, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the second judicial District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Harry T. Edwards

I was convicted under the name of Sam.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except One term in
the Idaho State Prison and Three terms
in the Utah State Prison
