and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of September  
A. D. 1928, at Duchesne County of Duchesne  
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Martin M. Larson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years - With a  
Recommendation of two months by the Judge and Prosecuting Attorney  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.
