and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. M. McCREA presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Alfred P. Boshard
I was convicted under the name of Harry Boshard

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Steal a Horse
Stealing a horse
