Application of Leland H. Ohlson

• To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parcel
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of October
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Leland H. Ohlson
I was convicted under the name of Leland H. Ohlson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None, though Eddid Myers was with me at the time of arrest
and was convicted of another charge.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery.
