Application of Albert Andrews No. 5179

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of April,  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkee presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 6 months  
to three years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Albert Leroy Andrews

I was convicted under the name of Albert Andrews

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Laurence Andrews.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
