Application of C. C. Jones #4757

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second-degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Sept A. D. 1926, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second-Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is C. C. Jones I was convicted under the name of C. C. Jones

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry Long

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except In San Francisco in March 1926 for second-degree burglary was granted probation from the bench.
