Application of WARREN A. WHELPLEY

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary Third Degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th. day of December A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. HANSEN presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than six months nor more than three years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. ROGERS prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is WARREN A. WHELPLEY, I was convicted under the name of WARREN A. WHELPLEY.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
