I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole to my mother
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of April
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence of from
one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cecil Oliver Rice
I was convicted under the name of Cecil Oliver Rice
