and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of April  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Harrison Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Sanderson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
Sugarhouse Utah

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Att. E. C. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank James

I was convicted under the name of Frank James

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Will. McDaniel

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except 1st. degree  
burglary in the State of Nevada.
