To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank James.

I was convicted under the name of James.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: William D. Daniels.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Records show.

In making Application for Conditional Pardon of sentence, I wish to leave the state.
