County and State aforesaid, Honorable W.E. Conkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

I was convicted under the name of Jack Hardy

burglary, State of Colo, 2nd degree burglary
State of Washington, Reform school sentences.
