Application of Jack Hardy No. 5138

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3d Dist. Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. W. McCoubie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Fine up to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable C. W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Geas Poland Wright

I was convicted under the name of Jack Hardy

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: William James, George Funk

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except

Two convictions second Degree burglary  
reform school sentences.
