Application of H. H. Nabors No. 4949

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination ~~of Parole~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of attempted Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of January A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third (3rd) district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable William M. Crea presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Adam Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Hubert Nabors I was convicted under the name of Edward H. Nabors

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Leland Elmer & Roy Sutherland (Clifton C. Cook.)

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except I was confined in the Utah State Prison December 31-1929 for Violation of Parole with Clifton C. Cook
