Application of Jerry Ribblet

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of March A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Jerry Ribblet I was convicted under the name of Jerry Ribblet

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joseph O. Helwig
