under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of July
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Burr presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one year
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable James M. Burr prosecuted the case.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except robbery
