Application of Pedro Duran No. 5029

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination for Deportation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with Intent to Kill

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of May A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate term of from one to five years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable (I do not know the name of the Pros. prosecuted the case. Attorney.)

Fifth-My true name in full is Pedro Duran I was convicted under the name of Pedro Duran

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown above
