I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole from State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of January, A. D. 1927, at Farmington, County of Davis and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.
