County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to A Indeterminate Sentence In Utah State
Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City,
Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John King
I was convicted under the name of John King

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery
