Application of John King No. 4369

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of April A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Richie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John King

I was convicted under the name of John King

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Thomas Moore

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on record.
