First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of March,
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Raymond K. Braly prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles A. Kramer
I was convicted under the name of Charles Kramer

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
