Application of James Elliott Fuson No. 4969

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of February A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Elliott Fuson I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Meyers

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
