I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Ransacking in third degree

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of March
A. D. 1927, at Morgan County of Morgan
and State of Utah, in Morgan County Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George D. Barker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to from 6 months to three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison. On the
10th day of March 1927 I was paroled Sept 13 1928

Fourth--Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Leonard Joseph Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Oliver Wilson

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except as above
