I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Persistent Violation of Liquor Law

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of November
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. J. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term with a
recommendation of fifteen months
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison from which
I was paroled May 17, 1926

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Gust Kallas
I was convicted under the name of Gust Kallas

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except
