Application of Harold P. Groves

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of November  
A. D. 1930, at Garland County of Iron  
and State of Utah, in Fifth District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Leroy H. Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from one to twenty years  
(1-20)

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harold P. Groves

I was convicted under the name of Harold P. Groves

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
