Application of Lester Larsen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of March,
A. D. 1927, at Duchesne County of Duchesne
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. O. Tucker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a minimum of one
year
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney Mr. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lester Delano Larsen
I was convicted under the name of Lester ~~Delano~~ Larsen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
and in this case was unwilling to accompany
this girl who came to me and
entreated me to go with her, and she
in revealing her moral weaknesses &
questioned her reason for such practices, when
what followed was
mutual and she Respectfully submitted,

told me she was
18 yrs. of age, under
paint and modern
dress. I believed
her. At court I was
honest in my statement
of Carnal Knowledge but
without a defending attorney, and
for the first time and in Roosevelt
a stranger, recently there, I
felt with fear I could not
defend myself.
