I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indefinite of Fine to Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. C. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Berry

I was convicted under the name of William Berry

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Joe Spaul

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none

I would prefer a conditional termination
to go to the oil fields in Parco M. Co. have experienced
in oil drilling and would like to have to carry on
my work again and take my stand again in the
world as a man.
