Application of William Berry No. 4935

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M.L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years of life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E.C. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Berry William Berry I was convicted under the name of William Berry.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joe Speel.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
