and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary second degree

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 15 day of October  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. Justice Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Mr. E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is W. Sullivan

I was convicted under the name of Walter Harris

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Apply for direct conditional termination to San Francisco  
California, my birth place purchasing transportation with
