Application of Joseph L. West No. 4880

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of June, A. D. 1927, at Duchesne County of Duchesne and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George P. Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. D. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph Leonard West I was convicted under the name of same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
