Application of Horatio Elliott No. 4609

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of September A. D. 1925, at Provo, County of Utah and State of Utah, in The Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George P. Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Horatio Elliott I was convicted under the name of Horatio Elliott

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Vern Steele and Alfred Davis

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE
