First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in *State Prison* under conviction and a sentence on a charge of *2nd degree burglary*

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the *7th* day of *October* A. D. *1927*, at *Salt Lake City* County of *Salt Lake* and State of Utah, in *3rd district* Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable *Chris Mathison* presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to *1 to 20 years* and thereafter was imprisoned in the *State Prison*

Fourth-Honorable *E. R. Rogers* prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is *George J. Zenaire* I was convicted under the name of *George J. Zenaire*

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: *Willie Sapon*

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except *what is on record, and on all of that.*
