First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Iron County, Jail, Parowan, Utah
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of practicing Chiropractic without a license

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of March
A. D. 1925, at Parowan County of Iron
and State of Utah, in The Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thos H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve 180 days in the County Jail of said County,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the said Iron County jail, for said 180 days, and
was committed to said jail on December 3rd, 1925
