Application of Roy Wilson Rice No. 5106

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Auto Theft

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of December
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence not
to exceed five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Judge C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Roy Wilson Rice
I was convicted under the name of Roy Wilson Rice
