A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in thrid Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not
to exceed over five (5) years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison
