and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt to Defraud

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of December
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Edwards
I was convicted under the name of Frank Edwards

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except One.
Confidence charge. Convicted at Denver Colo., November 1920.
Sentenced from one year to fifteen months.
