I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of September
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A. E. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Morgan John Richmond
I was convicted under the name of Morgan John Richmond
