Application of Jose Abran Pantoja

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of May
A. D. 1926, at Coalville, Utah County of Summit
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jose Abran Pantoja
I was convicted under the name of Jose Abran Pantoja

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which now
serving.
