Application of Erroll Hynes No. 5324

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of January
A. D. 1930, at Nephi County of Joub.
and State of Utah, in Fifth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge LeRoy Cox presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to one to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable L. C. Larsen Dist. Att. prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Thomas Erroll Hynes
I was convicted under the name of Erroll Hynes

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery
twice in the State of Utah. The complaints
of said conviction being sworn to by parties
more or less connected with Bootlegging
operations. Whiskey has caused me to get into
trouble both times.
