

Salt Lake City, Utah, March 26th. 1932

Application of John Bonza No. 5773

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison, from which I am now on parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge of a female under the age of 18 yrs and over the age of 13 year.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of March A. D. 1929, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of imprisonment of not to exceed five years on April 8th., 1929 and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison of Utah

Fourth-Honorable F.W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Bonza

I was convicted under the name of John Bonza

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above mentioned
