To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of April
A. D. 1929, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Smith presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
at One Day to Five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Frank H. Taylor prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Bonza

I was convicted under the name of John Bonza

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
