Application of Lawrence Alsop

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION For Govt. Prison and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of FORGERY

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27, day of November A. D. 1935, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Parnell Black prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Lawrence E. Alsop

I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Govt. Lyer Act Sentenced May 2nd 1936 Said Sentence To run Concurrently with the sentence I am noe serving.
